



The Arkansas Symphony Orchestra presents the 30th annual
SUMMER STRINGS CAMP
June 24-28, 2019

The Arkansas Symphony Orchestra announces a comprehensive week-long summer music program for violin, viola, cello, string bass, and harp players at the elementary, junior high, and high school levels. Students must have had at least one year of study on their particular instruments and should be reading music.

ACTIVITIES: Activities are tailored specifically for students of three different age levels:

- **Elementary students (grades K-6)** will perform in the Concert Orchestra, participate in music theory classes, and play in like-instrument ensembles.
- **Junior High students (grades 7-9)** will perform in the Philharmonic orchestra, receive coaching on South Region Orchestra audition music, and play in like-instrument ensembles.
- **Senior High students (grades 10-12)** will study chamber music repertoire at an advanced level. Additionally, these students will focus on the South Region Orchestra/Arkansas All-State Orchestra audition material; work on scales, sight-reading, and advanced technique; and perform in like-instrument ensembles as well.
- **Harp Program** for young harpists to work on technique and ensemble literature, as well as participate in orchestra rehearsals.

LOCATION: **Pulaski Heights United Methodist Church**, 4823 Woodlawn Drive, Little Rock
Drop-off and pick-up should take place in the Lee Avenue circle drive and parking garage

SCHEDULE: Camp will meet from 1:30-5:00 pm daily for the week of June 25-29. Students will participate in orchestra rehearsals, music theory classes/region audition sectionals, and like-instrument ensembles. Snacks and a short break will be provided each day.

CONCERT: The camp week will conclude with a concert performance at **4:30 pm on Friday, June 28**. The concert will take place in Wesley Hall on the PHUMC campus. Admission to the concert is free, and families are encouraged to attend. A reception honoring all of the students will be held in the lobby following the performance.

TUITION: **\$150 Early Bird Discount Registration** (*application received by June 1st*)
\$175 Regular registration (*application received after June 1st*)
Tuition includes camp t-shirt; sizes guaranteed if application is received by June 1st.

FACULTY: All of our faculty are affiliated with the Arkansas Symphony Orchestra and have been performing and teaching for many years. Casey Buck, the Camp Director, is an ASO cellist, ASYO Preparatory Orchestra director, and Conway Public Schools orchestra director.

PRIVATE LESSONS: A limited number of private lessons are available before or after the regular program. Lessons should be arranged with the instructor of your choice on a first-come, first-served basis. Fees will be determined by each teacher and should be paid directly to the instructor.
